Municipal Code	Description
OC 110.03 (O-10-16)	Every business entity engaged in any trade, occupation, employment, business, or profession shall be required to obtain the occupational license and pay a license tax therefor herein provided, prior to beginning to engage in the business and thereafter, on or before the fifteenth day of the fourth month following the end of the taxable year of the business entity.
CO 90.21 (O-38-12)	It shall be the duty of the owner or occupants of lots abutting on sidewalks to keep the sidewalks in front of the property or lots clean and free from rubbish and dirt, whether they are washed by water flooding the sidewalks or from any other source.
ZG 3520 (O-24-22) Temporary TST	Prior to placing any Temporary Storage Trailer (TST) on any property, a TST permit must be obtained.
ZG 400 (O-24-22)	No building, accessory structure, or other structure shall be erected, moved, added to, structurally altered, nor shall any building, structure, or land be established or changed in use or character without a permit. Permits are also required for tenant finishes for previously occupied structures and where tenants were not known at the time when Site Plan Review was conducted for a completed structure.
PM 303.2 (O-11-03)	All exterior surfaces shall be maintained in good condition. Exterior wood surfaces, other than decay resistant woods, shall be protected from the elements and decay by painting or other protective covering or treatment. Peeling, flaking and chipped paint shall be eliminated and surfaces repainted. All siding and masonry joints shall be maintained weather resistant and water tight. All metal surfaces subject to rust and corrosion shall be stabilized and treated to to inhibit future rust and corrosion.
NS 305.1 (O-11-03)	All exterior property and premises, and the interior of every structure, shall be free from any accumulation of rubbish or garbage. Such accumulation is hereby declared a nuisance.
PM 302.4.2 (O-11-03)	All landscape areas and landscape plantings shall be maintained in good condition, free of weeds and other unsightly vegetation. All landscaping including shrubs, brush, hedges, or other vegetation shall be maintained and trimmed when necessary to prevent overgrowth.
ZG 3610 (O-24-22)	Property owners are responsible for maintenance of all required landscaping materials, and shall keep all plants in a proper, neat and orderly appearance, free from refuse and debris at all times. All unhealthy or dead plant material shall be replaced by the next planting season.
ZG 3312 (O-24-22)	All parking areas shall be striped to facilitate the movement in and out of the parking stalls. This includes the delineation of access isles and permitted turning movements. The entrances and exits to the parking area shall be clearly marked. All signage and striping will be adequately maintained to insure safe and efficient movement of vehicles.

If you fail to pay the civil fine set forth in the citation or contest the citation, within the time allowed, you are deemed to have waived the right to a hearing before the code enforcement board to contest the citation and the determination that a violation was committed shall be final, and you are also deemed to have waived the right to appeal the final order to Boone County District Court. This citation must accompany payment and should be paid in person or by mail to the City of Florence Finance Department, 8100 Ewing Boulevard, Florence, KY 41042. Office hours are 830am-5pm, Monday-Friday. Business phone (859) 647-5413.

CONTESTING THE CITATION

A written request for a hearing to contest the citation must be made **within seven (7) days of date issued**. Such request for hearing shall be filed in the office of the Florence City Clerk, 8100 Ewing Boulevard, Florence, KY 41042. Office hours are 830am-5pm, Monday-Friday. Business phone (859) 647-8177. An appeal from the Code Enforcement Board's determination may be made to the Boone County District Court within thirty (30) days of the determination provided you did not fail to appear. Failure to appear waives the right to appeal the final order to Boone County District Court.

Total due balances are not carried forward. If you receive two or more citations, balance is due for EACH citation.
