Special Techniques

- Alternate Light Source Demonstration Reveal hidden stains or writing using a black light.
- Toolmark or Bite Mark Comparison Introductory exercise in matching physical patterns to tools or molds.
- Using Safe Chemicals- Use of chemicals to help us identify and enhance prints.
