CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE 0-18-2025

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY ESTABLISHING A DISABILITY SIGNAGE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City desires to establish a policy and procedure for the application, review, and installation of "PERSON WITH DISABILITY AREA" signs in residential areas, and

WHEREAS, the City desires to provide for and promote the safety of individuals with disabilities by alerting motorists of their presence in the immediate area; insuring compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA"); and fostering an inclusive community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF FLORENCE, KENTUCKY, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

For purposes of this Ordinance, the term "Disability" shall be that as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act as Amended.

SECTION II

The City of Florence hereby establishes criteria and procedures for requesting and installing "PERSON WITH DISABILITY AREA" signs within residential areas. Said criteria and procedures being more particularly defined and set forth in the attached "Disability Signage Program" identified as Exhibit "A".

SECTION III

Upon adoption of this Ordinance, the City of Florence Human Services Administrator and Public Services Department shall forthwith implement all of the terms, conditions, and provisions of the Disability Signage Program.

SECTION IV

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.

SECTION V

This Ordinance shall be published by posting on the City's internet website.
