

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE CONTROL INFORMATION

The City of Florence is classified as a wet territory within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. We offer a variety of alcoholic beverage licenses dependent upon the nature of business and establishment to be licensed. In order to obtain a license, a completed application must be received and approved by the City of Florence. All licenses are effective from December 1 through November 30 and must be renewed on an annual basis.

The City of Florence has agreed to accept the application(s) published by the Commonwealth of Kentucky's Department of Alcoholic Beverage Control. The legal advertisement required by the application MUST be published in the **Boone**County Recorder (513-242-4000). The City of Florence Alcoholic Beverage License will not be issued until the local Occupational License has been secured and the State license(s) has been issued and a copy of same has been submitted to the City of Florence.

When any person applies for a license authorized to be issued by the City of Florence on or after June 1 of any year, he shall be charged an amount equal to one-half of the annual license fee, until the following December 1, except that no license shall be issued for a shorter period than six months. No abatement of license fees shall be permitted to any person who held a license of the same kind for the same premises in the preceding license period and who was actually doing business under the license during the last month of the preceding license period. All licenses must be renewed annually before November 30.

Before commencing or doing any business for the time for which a license has been issued, the license shall be posted and at all times displayed in a conspicuous place in the room or principal room where the business is carried on, so that all persons visiting the place may readily see the license.

- Limited restaurant license (includes distilled spirits, wine, and malt beverages), per annum \$1,200.00
- Limited golf course license (includes distilled spirits, wine and malt beverages), per annum \$1,200.00

The fee for each of the first five (5) supplemental bar licenses shall be the same as the fee for the primary drink license. There shall be no charge for each supplemental license issued in excess of five (5) to the same licensee at the same premises.

The holder of a nonquota retail malt beverage package license may obtain a Nonquota type 4 malt beverage drink license for a fee of fifty dollars (\$50). The holder of a Nonquota type 4 malt beverage drink license may obtain a nonquota retail malt beverage package license for a fee of fifty dollars (\$50).

HOURS WHEN SALES PERMITTED

Distilled spirits licenses as follows:

- Distiller's license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Rectifier's license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Quota retail package license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Quota retail drink license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Special temporary license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Nonquota type 1 retail drink license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Nonquota type 2 retail drink license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Nonquota type 3 retail drink license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Distilled spirits and wine special temporary auction license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Special Sunday retail drink license: 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday
- Extended hours supplemental license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 4:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to 2:30 a.m. on Sunday. NOTE: Only available to holders of a Nonquota Type 1 license.
- Caterer's license: During the period between 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 1:00 p.m. to midnight on Sunday.

Malt beverage licenses as follows:

- Brewer's license: During the period between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 11:00 a.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- *Microbrewery license*: During the period between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 11:00 a.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Malt beverage distributor's license: During the period between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 11:00 a.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Nonquota retail malt beverage package license: During the period between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 11:00 a.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Nonquota type 4 retail malt beverage drink license: During the period between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 11:00 a.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Malt beverage brew-on-premises license: During the period between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 11:00 a.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Limited restaurant license (includes distilled spirits, wine, and malt beverages): During the period between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 11:00 a.m. to midnight on Sunday.
- Limited golf course license (includes distilled spirits, wine, and malt (beverages): During the period between the hours of 6:00 a.m. to 2:30 a.m. daily except Sunday and from 11:00 a.m. to midnight on Sunday.
